

Delinquent Property Tax Timeline for 2009 Taxes

This Year

Delinquency

On March 1, 2010

Unpaid 2009 taxes become delinquent and payable to Jackson County Treasurer

- ◆ 4% Administrative Fee added
- ◆ Interest begins to accrue at 12% per year

On Oct 1, 2010


\$15 fee added

On Nov 1, 2010

Parcel added to preliminary forfeiture list

On Feb 1, 2011

Mortgage lenders and banks may be notified

Next Year

Forfeiture

On March 1, 2011

- ◆ Minimum of \$195 in fees added
- ◆ Property forfeited to County Treasurer
- ◆ Interest rate increased to 18% per year retroactive to March 1, 2010

June 2011

Foreclosure petition filed in Circuit

Between June 1, 2011 and January 31, 2012

Title research to identify owners and lienholders

Personal visits made to forfeited property

Mortgage lenders banks and other lienholders notified

Early 2012

January 2012

Show Cause Hearing held

Foreclosure

February 2012

Court Hearing held and Judge signs Foreclosure Order

March 31, 2012

Redemption rights expire if taxes are not paid and property ownership transfers to the Jackson County Treasurer

July-November 2012

- ◆ Property sold at auction
- ◆ Prior owner does not receive any of the proceeds
