March 1, 2008	Unpaid 2007 taxes returned delinquent to the County Treasurer for collection. (MCL 211.78a)	4% administrative interest + 1% per month
June 1, 2008	First mail notice- County Treasurer sends out notice of delinquency via first class mail to taxpayer of record. (MCL 211.78b)	
Sept. 1, 2008	Second Mail Notice- County Treasurer sends out notice of delinquency via first class mail to taxpayer of record. (MCL 211.78c)	
October 1, 2008	\$15.00 fee- County Treasurer adds \$15.00 fee to each parcel for which delinquent taxes remain unpaid. (MCL 211.78d)	\$15.00
February 1, 2009	Third Mail Notice (Certified)- County Treasurer sends notice of delinquency and pending forfeiture via certified mail to taxpayer of record. (MCL 211.78f)	
March 1, 2009	Forfeiture- Property forfeited to County Treasurer: Treasurer adds \$175.00 fee and recording fee. Interest increases from 1% per month to 1.5% per month computed retroactively to March 2008. (MCL 211.78g)	1.5% interest \$20.00 recording fees \$175.00 administrative fee
March 1, 2009- April 15, 2009	Certificate of Forfeiture- County Treasurer records certificates of forfeiture with the Register of Deeds. (MCL 211.78g)	
May 1, 2009- Dec. 1, 2009	Title Search- FGU (Foreclosing Governmental Unit) conducts title search of property to identify owners entitled to notice. (MCL 211.78i)	
June 15, 2009	Foreclosure Petition- FGU files foreclosure petition with Circuit Court. (MCL 211.78h)	

June 15, 2009- Jan. 31, 2010	Certified mail notice of Foreclosure- Notice of foreclosure sent by certified mail at least 30 days before show cause hearing. (MCL 211.78i)	court costs certified mail costs service fees
June 15, 2009- Jan. 31, 2010	Personal visit-FGU agent visits each property forfeited and serves copy of notice of foreclosure, and verbally informs occupant of foreclosure; if unoccupied, a notice will be posted. (MCL 211.78i)	
June 15, 2009- Feb. 2010	Published notice- notice by publication for 3 successive weeks. (MCL 211.78i)	publication fee
	Show cause hearing- FGU conducts administrative show cause hearing no later than 7 days before foreclosure hearing. (MCL 211.78j)	
Jan. 30, 2010- March 31, 2010	Foreclosure hearing- Circuit court hearing on foreclosure petition. (MCL 211.78k)	court costs
March 31, 2010	Entry of Judgment- Circuit court enters Judgment of Foreclosure. (MCL 211.78k)	
	Clear title to foreclosed property vests in FGU and redemption rights expire in uncontested cases. Redemption rights expire 21 days after judgment in contested cases. (MCL 211.78k)	
	Appeal- FGU or person with interest in foreclosed property may appeal to court of appeals. (MCL 211.78k)	
	FGU records judgment or notice of judgment with County Register of Deeds. (MCL 211.78k)	recording costs
July - Oct 2010	First Land Auction with set minimum bids; Local government or county may obtain for minimum bid. State, if not FGU, may obtain by paying market value. (MCL 211.78m)	any costs incurred in bringing the property to sale.
July - Nov 2010	Second Land Auction with no minimum bids. (MCL 211.78m)	
Dec. 1, 2010- Dec. 31, 2010	Unsold property may be transferred with consent to city, village, or township. (MCL 211.78m)	
Dec. 31, 2010	Unsold property not sold or transferred is retained by FGU. (MCL 211.78m)
