BOIL WATER ADVISORY LIFTED FOR LEONI TOWNSHIP WATER USERS

THURSDAY, APRIL 29, 2021 – Leoni Township, MI: A boil water advisory issued earlier this week as a precautionary measure has been lifted for the Leoni Township Water System.

Rob Jones, the operator-in-charge of the Leoni Township Water System, said today that all subsequent sampling and water analysis shows that the water is safe and meets the state's drinking water standards. No contaminants were found.

It is recommended, however, that all customers – households and businesses – flush lines by running taps for a few minutes before drinking the water.
