If you have Medicaid Health Insurance, you may qualify to receive **FREE** services for you and your baby.

Applying for services is simple. If you or your baby already has Medicaid, call 768-2114 to make an appointment. If you need to apply for Medicaid, call 788-4420 for information.

The Maternal Infant Health Program (MIHP) can help you if you need assistance with any of the following:

- Accessing benefits through your Medicaid Health Plan
- Help with getting health services
- Free childbirth or parenting classes
- Breastfeeding support
- Community resources
- Nutrition guidance
- Connection to other services offered in the Jackson community.



You may be eligible for the program if:

- You are pregnant
- You have an infant under 1 year old
- You have Medicaid
