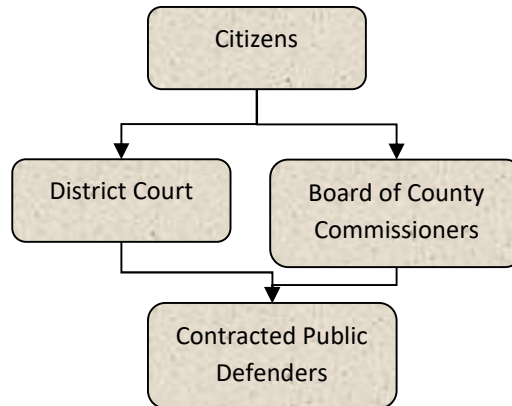

The public defender non-criminal program supports the safe community strategic priority by providing for attorney services that the Michigan Indigent Defense Commission (MIDC) does not cover.

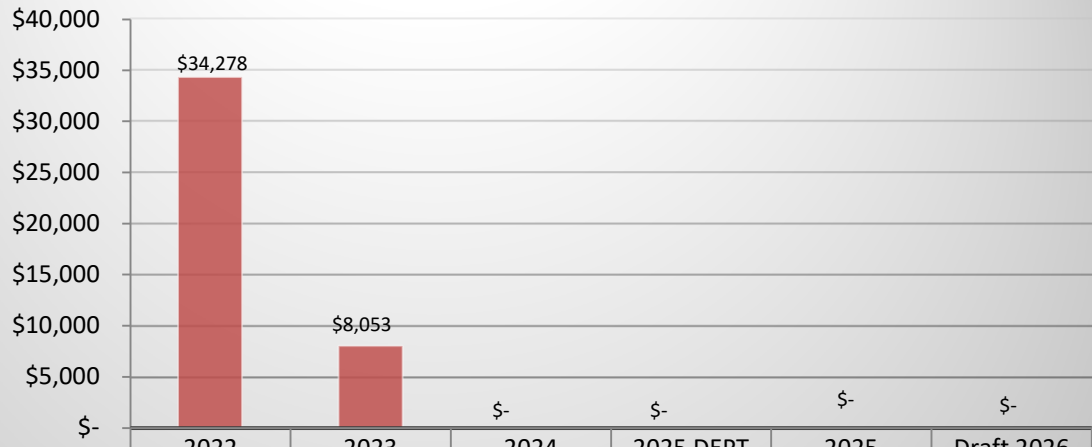
