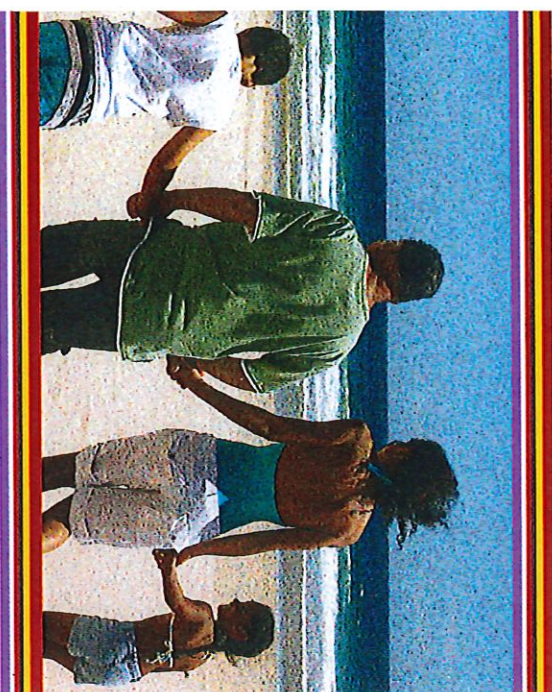

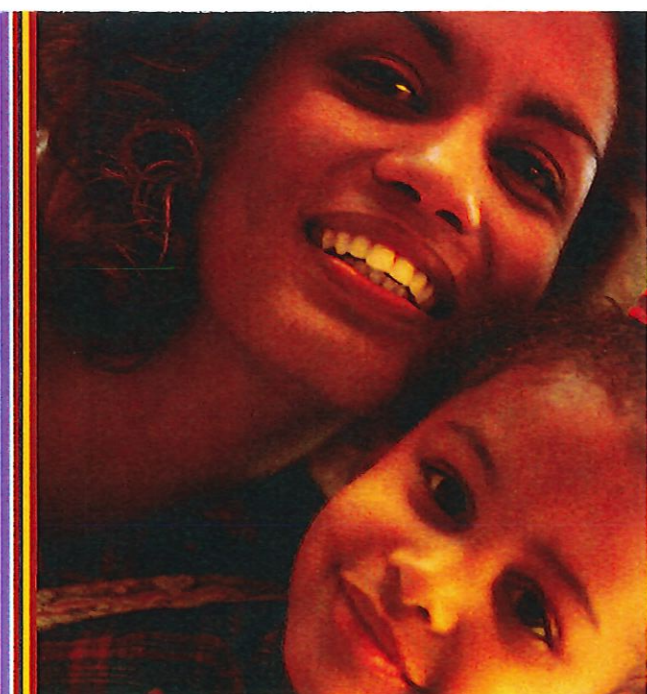

THE FAMILY CENTER

The Family Center for Children and Youth with Special Health Care Needs (Family Center) is the statewide parent-directed center within Children's Special Health Care Services (CSHCS).

We support all families of children and youth with special health care needs, including all children who have, or are at an increased risk for: physical, developmental, behavioral, or emotional conditions.

- Providing peer support and information to families.
- Partnering with local health departments to connect families to services and supports.
- Promoting family/professional partnerships and the parental perspective on programs and policies affecting Children and Youth with Special Health Care Needs.
