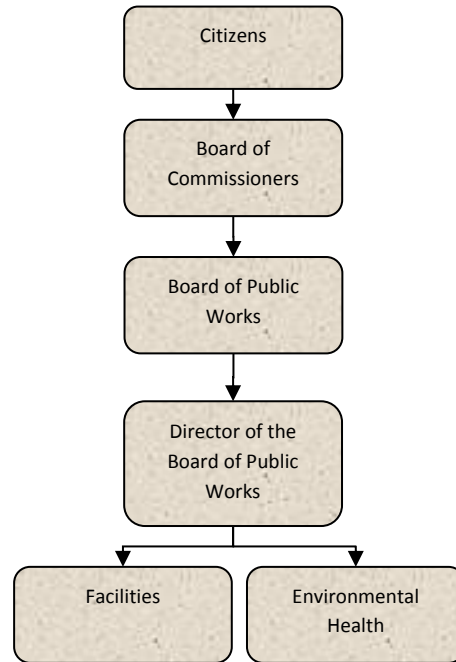




Landfill/ Public Works

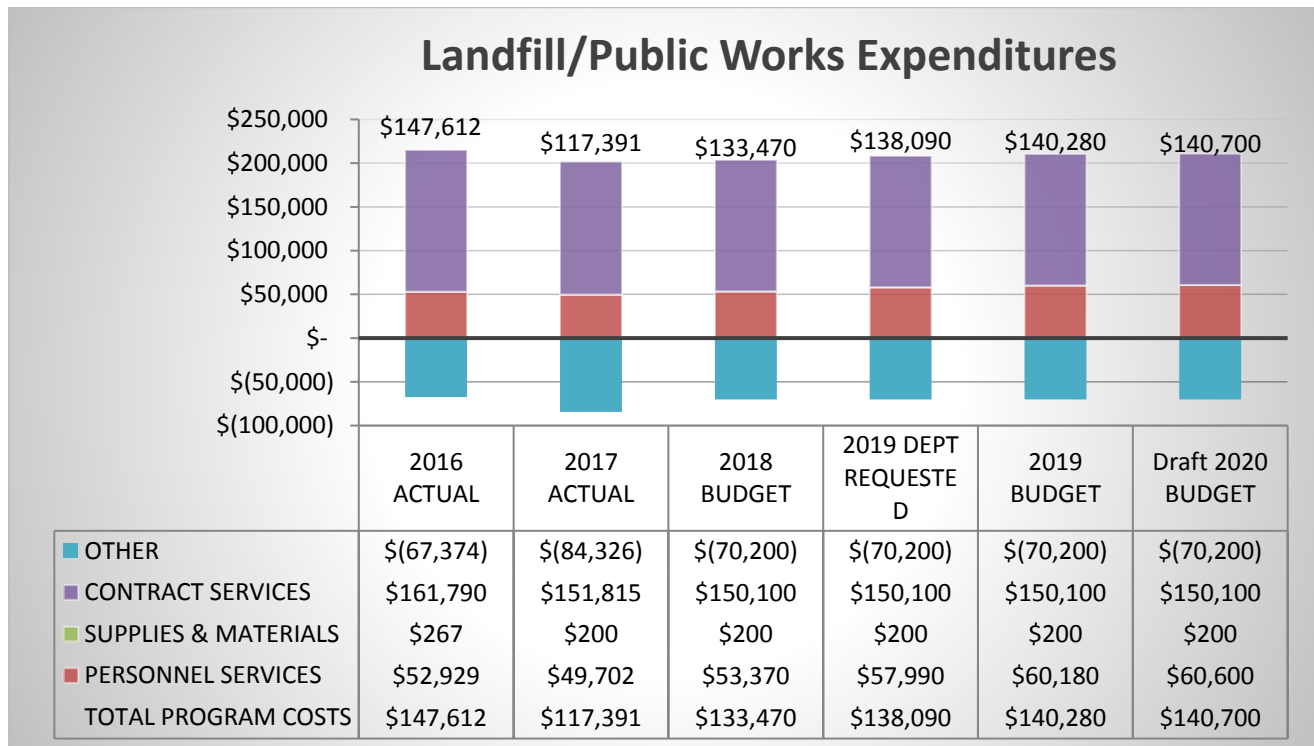

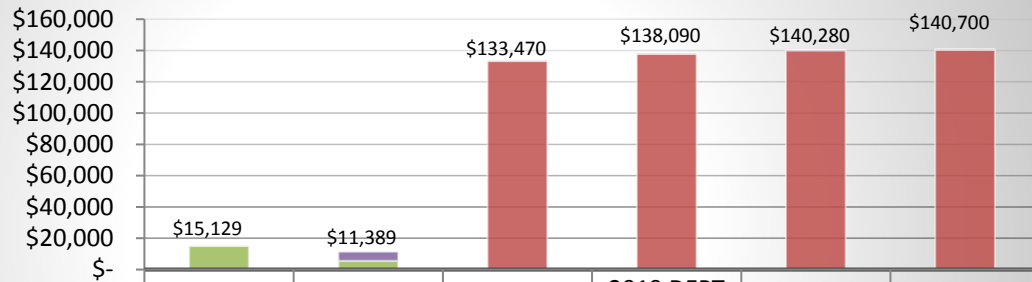
